

# 10 Tips

## To Prepare Students for MAP<sup>®</sup> Testing

1. MAP tests are unique to each student – no two are alike!
2. It's ok not to know the answer – it is expected!

3. You can't go back once you hit "Go On" or "Enter."
4. You cannot skip items – if it's getting too hard, the test will adjust!

5. The test is not timed – take your time!
6. Use your best test-taking skills, such as eliminating wrong answers.

**The most important step before any assessment is to explain its purpose and what you will do with the results. Tell your students:**

7. Let the teacher know if you need help using a mouse, keyboard, scroll bars, and pop-up calculators.
8. The teacher or proctor may tell you where to sit.

9. You cannot use textbooks, other materials, or hand-held calculators.
10. Listen carefully to the proctor's directions!
