## To Prepare Students for MAP® Testing

- 1. MAP tests are unique to each student no two are alike!
- 2. It's ok not to know the answer it is expected!
- 3. You can't go back once you hit "Go On" or "Enter."
- 4. You cannot skip items if it's getting too hard, the test will adjust!
- 5. The test is not timed take your time!
- 6. Use your best test-taking skills, such as eliminating wrong answers.

The most important step before any assessment is to explain its purpose and what you will do with the results. Tell your students:

- 7. Let the teacher know if you need help using a mouse, keyboard, scroll bars, and pop-up calculators.
- 8. The teacher or proctor may tell you where to sit.
- 9. You cannot use textbooks, other materials, or hand-held calculators.
- 10. Listen carefully to the proctor's directions!
