After School Activity Info - With our sports, clubs, and choir pick up location being different than last year, we didn't realize there would be a little snafu with basketball and aftercare. Basketball is TUESDAYS and THURSDAYS. All practices are listed on the school website: <a href="https://holytrinitynmb.com/">https://holytrinitynmb.com/</a>. If your child is on the basketball team, pick up will be at 4:30 PM from the brown side MPR door. Due to multiple things going on in the back of the school after hours, we ask that you park in a parking space in one of the back lots and not pull up until 4:25 PM. We have to allow other traffic (Seton bus and aftercare) to be able to pick up as well.

If your child is in aftercare, please pull in the fenced in area slowly. Park in a space closest to the gates and walk down the sidewalk to the back door to get your child. The students who are at basketball practice will be aware of their surroundings. When leaving, please pull out and drive back the way you came to allow for the practice to continue as uninterrupted as possible. After 4:30 PM, we can go back to our regular procedures. Thank you for your cooperation with these pick up procedures.

**Veterans Day Program** - All families are invited to join us for a special program honoring our military Veterans on **Monday, 11/11**, at **1:30 PM** in the multipurpose room (mpr). Students may wear red, white, and blue clothing and shoes appropriate for recess that day.
