If you are intending to seek tuition assistance for the 24-25 school year, please see the information below about grants and scholarships. All families seeking assistance MUST complete the financial aid application on FACTS and MUST apply for all applicable grants and/or scholarships.

There are several grant and scholarship opportunities this year and all are due back in March. Below is a listing and attached is the information.

- Mary Gabelli Mazzolla Scholarship open to all families seeking tuition assistance
- St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Grant open to all Catholic families seeking tuition assistance
- **Educational Scholarship Trust Fund Grant** open to all current K4 families going into Kindergarten in the fall and seeking tuition assistance
- **First Steps 4K Grant** open to all families with students going into K4 who will be four-years-old on or before September 1 and seeking tuition assistance

Parents, We Need Your Help... As we move into the final months of this school year, below are some important things parents can help their students learn:

- their parents'/guardians' names (first and last)
- their parents'/guardians' phone numbers (with area code)
- their own address (street, town, and state)
- how to tie their shoes
- how to put on and secure their jackets (zippers, buttons, etc.)
- how to get out of the car (once in the unloading zone see attached)

Our focus during those times is the safety of our students as they come in and out of school and keeping the line moving so parents can get where they need to in a timely manner.
