Your child is eligible to receive services in the area(s) indicated below. These services will be provided by Catapult Learning ("Catapult") and will be paid for by the school district using federal or local grants, programs or appropriations including but not limited to Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) and Coronavirus Aid, Relief, Economic Security Act (CARES), and Emergency Assistance to Non Public Schools (EANS) to the extent available and applicable.

It is recommended that your child receives the following service(s) as indicated:

[] Speech - Services provide targeted intervention to address speech/language issues that have been found through a speech/language evaluation to interfere with communication and school functioning.

While your child receives services, Catapult will receive personally identifiable information ("PII") related to your child which is protected under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA").

Services may be administered in-person in traditional classrooms or virtually, through Catapult through DPPs., posting materials accessible to our students, and parent consultations that may use live audio, video or recordings.

While participating in the services, PII may be overheard by other students, parents or third parties and you consent to the disclosure of your child's PII and our use of the DPPs identified above. We are required to tell you that certain digital tools we use collect personal information from students and we may share that data solely for the purpose of delivering our services.

We will not sell or use any student data for commercial use. DPPs commit to protecting the privacy of K-12 users and comply with the requirements of the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act ("COPPA"), the California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA"), FERPA, and other applicable laws.

If you object to the collection of your student's data by the DPP used, please contact us in writing and we will work with you to determine another way to provide services to your child. DPPs have security settings that help to prevent unauthorized use or intrusion into video or audio meetings and although our teachers are trained and will activate these settings, we cannot be responsible or liable for the actions of an unauthorized user or intruder into the DPPs.
