Catholic schools dominate national test average scores... The Main National Assessment of Education Progress, or the "Nation's Report Card," has published the 2022 state-by-state national scores. The report included representative samples of national testing scores from Catholic, charter, and traditional public schools. The results support that Catholic schools outperformed others during the COVID-19 pandemic amid widespread test-score declines. This success is attributed to the continuation of in-person learning and dedicated families and is the reason for carried over success post-pandemic.
