- Drop off / Pick Up Please have your students ready to exit the cars each morning once you are a few car lengths past the gates and at a complete stop. Students should go to the sidewalk as quickly as they can. Also, please remain in your cars at all times during both drop off and pick up. We will assist younger students who need help. Please share car line procedure information with anyone who may be picking up your children on your behalf.
- Hot Lunch Update Our application to DHEC was submitted last week. If all goes well, we hope to open the
 program in October. A monthly menu will be sent home in advance so parents can review the daily options,
 choose which days, if any, their student wishes to purchase lunches, and return the menu with payment. Because
 we need to preorder food, no late orders will be accepted.
- MAP testing Per Diocesan policy, all students in grades K-5 will participate in standardized MAP testing three times each year. These assessments provide valuable information for teachers, students, and parents regarding student progress throughout the year. Our school calendar lists the dates for fall MAP tests as September 9-23, but the window is September 6-23. Teachers will advise parents of the specific dates their classes will be testing. Getting a good night's rest, eating a healthy breakfast, and being in school on time is essential to a student's success on the MAP assessments.
