My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I write concerning my support of the educational programs we have chosen for both our adults as well as the children and youth in the Diocese of Charleston.

The USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People requires that dioceses provide training for appropriate persons "about ways to make and maintain a safe environment for children and young people" (Charter, Article 12). To implement this directive, the Diocese of Charleston currently uses two educational programs; Safe Haven, from Catholic Mutual, to train all our employees and volunteers with access to minors, and Teaching Safety - Empowering God's Children Program from Virtus, to educate our minors. As Bishop of Charleston, I find these educational programs to be both sound in educational value as well as valuable in promoting Catholic beliefs and teachings.

I approve and endorse these programs as a vehicle to meet both our responsibility of protecting our children as well as meeting our Charter and Policy mandates.
