### What are Paw Coins?

Paw coins are positive reinforcement currency. Students earn paw coins by demonstrating good ROAR behavior. Students will have a paw pouch in which to keep their coins. This pouch remains at school as they accumulate their coins. They may save or spend paw coins in the ROAR Store. Throughout the year there will be special ROAR events which will celebrate good ROAR behavior. Students who have earned the designated number of paw coins will be eligible to attend these ROAR celebrations.

## Recess

### **Respectful**

- Take turns and be considerate
- Choose teams fairly
- Share equipment

### **Organized**

- Promptly line up when called
- Return equipment to its place

- Report unsafe behavior or equipment

## Mass/Assemblies

### **Respectful**

### **Organized**

- Fill in each seat in the row
- Enter and exit with your class quietly
- Use bathroom before

### **Appropriate**

- Sit still and remain seated
- Keep hands and feet to yourself
- Raise hand and wait to be recognized

- Pursue excellence: ask topic related questions at appropriate times

## ***What is "ROAR"ing Behavior?***

### Classroom

#### **Respectful**

- Speak kindly
- Get permission to use someone else's things
- Work quietly
- Cooperate with others

#### **Organized**

- Have all of your supplies ready
- Keep your area clean
- Turn your best work in on time, every time

#### **Appropriate**

- Treat others the way you want to be treated
- Do your best

#### **Responsible**

- Be on time and ready to learn
- Follow directions
- Ask for help
- Complete assignments on time and bring to school

### Hallway

#### **Respectful**

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
- Move silently and stay in your place in line

#### **Organized**

- Keep up with your class
- Know where you are going and what you need to do
- Carefully hold your belongings

#### **Appropriate**

- Walk and stay to the right of the hall
- Greet and/or respond to greetings quietly and politely

#### **Responsible**

- Go directly to your destination
- Have a hall pass when necessary
- Be considerate of other people's learning environments and work displayed in hallways

## Bathroom

### **Respectful**

- Honor others' privacy
- Remember to flush

### **Organized**

- Use at assigned times
- Wait your turn quietly

### **Appropriate**

- Use the restroom, wash your hands and leave quietly
- Keep the bathroom clean
- Use supplies sparingly

### **Responsible**

- Return to your area/group
- Report any unsafe behavior or bathroom conditions

## Lunch Area

### **Respectful**

- Use soft voices
- Chew with mouth closed and use manners
- Lights off means stop talking

### **Organized**

- Bring your lunch every day
- Have your own napkins and utensils

### **Appropriate**

- Raise your hand to get permission to get out of your seat
- Walk at all times

### **Responsible**

- Clean up any dropped items or spills
- Leave area clean and trash in cans
- Push chairs under table when leaving
- Raise your hand if you need help
